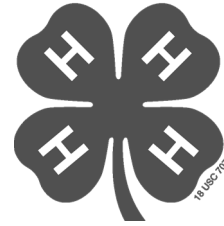

All money raised from the sale of these baskets and other items go to college scholarships for Lemhi County 4-H Youth. Each year 5 to 10 scholarships are given in an amount between \$250 to \$1000 depending on the number of youth who apply and the amount of money raised.

- Beef are shrunk 2.6% for sale weight
- Animals sold thru the Junior Livestock sale will become the property of the buyer. If the buyer wishes to resale the animal, it will be sold to the floor buyer or those on the resale list.
- Resale animals are sold on a first come/first serve basis and purchasers do not have a choice of a specific animal they wish to purchase.
- All animals will remain at the fair grounds and in appropriate pens until **7:00 p.m. Saturday, August 25, 2018.**
- **All exhibit animals must be removed from the fairgrounds by 12pm on Sunday August 26, 2018.**
