- Beans** 5 -Fresh with stems
- Beets** 3 -With 1-2 inch stems
- Broccoli** 2
- Cabbage** 1
- Carrots** 3 -With 1-2 inch stems
- Cauliflower** 1

- Corn** 3 Ears -Husked, kernels filled to end
- Cucumbers** 2-Slicing and/or 3 Pickling with 1/4 inch of stem
- Eggplant** 2
- Garlic** 3 bulbs
- Kohlrabi** 2 Heads
- Lettuce** 1 Head
- Onions** 3-With some dry husks and cured neck
- Parsnips** 3 -With 1-2 inch stems
- Peas** 5 pods—garden, snow or sugarsnap
- Peppers** 3 with stems -(3 entries of different varieties allowed)
- Potatoes** 3-(2 entries of different varieties allowed)
- Pumpkin** 1- With 2-3 inch stem
- Squash, Summer** 2 - (2 entries of different varieties allowed)
- Squash, Winter** 1 -(2 entries of different varieties allowed)
- Tomatoes** 3-Ripe OR 3 green, with stems, no branches
- Tomatoes, Cherry** 5-Ripe OR 5 green, with stems, no branches
- Unclassified Vegetable**

Herbs

3 entries of different varieties per class allowed

- Fresh** 1 bunch all one type (3 entries)
- Dried** 1 bunch all one type (3 entries)
- Potted** 1 type per pot; max 8" pot (3 entries)

Other Agriculture

- Eggs** 6 2 entries of different varieties allowed (i.e. chicken, duck)
- Honey** 1 jar
- Sheaf Grains or Grasses**
- Sunflower** 1 seed head

Fruits

- Apples** 3 with stems
- Apricots** 3
- Berries** 5 with stems
(3 entries different varieties)
- Cherries** 5 with stems
- Currants**
3 clusters red, black, or white
- Grapes** 3 Clusters
- Melon** 1

Seniors (70+), Adult(18+), Intermediate(13-17), Junior (6-12) or Rookie(5 and under)

Submission Guidelines

1. Entries are limited to Lemhi County grown products and must be grown by exhibitor.
2. **NOTE!** Limit of 30 entries per person (due to limited exhibit space).
3. **NOTE!** 1 entry per class or variety per person (except where noted).
4. All articles must be cleaned and prepared for exhibit prior to entry.
5. In general, only trim roots (clean), Trim stems to 1"-2".
6. Entries to be judged on lack of defects, and condition (i.e. smooth, unblemished surfaces, free from worm holes or disease). Entries also judged on form typical for variety (most acceptable commercial size and color). In general entries will be judged on the kind of vegetable or fruit a customer shopping for produce will prefer.
