- Halter and performance classes will run continuously until 12:00 noon.
- Trail classes will be held at a time to be announced on show day.
- AQHA rules are used as a guide in judging.
- No practicing of the trail course allowed on show day.
- Age of contestants will be determined by their age as of January 1, 2020.
- A horse or rider can only qualify once per division toward the High Point Horse. Likewise, if a person rides more than one horse in an event, only the highest score will count toward High Point Youth or Adult.
- \*Lead-line classes for 5 & under. A child competing in this class is not eligible to enter other 0-7 classes and earn points.
- \*No Stallions may be used in any youth class.
- Entries close at 10am. Late fees apply after Sunday, August 23rd.
