

# Rancher Roundup

**Eligibility:** An All-Around Rancher Award will be given to the individual with the most points from the four events. Contestants must reside in the Salmon River Drainage or be a native of the same to win the all-around rancher award. To qualify for the all-around award, contestants must compete in at least three of the four events.

**Events:** The Rancher Roundup will consist of four separate events. Current events are the Salmon River Roping Association (SRRA) Drainage Team Roping, Ranch Horse Cutting, Single Cow Fence work, and Team Sorting. All events will have a jackpot payout.

**Entries:** Entries will be taken until event starts. Fees are listed with the event descriptions.

**Points:** Points will be awarded as follows-Places one through ten get 10 points and down except points will be increased by 1 point per place for each additional 5 entries above the first 10 entries. Contestant can only earn points from their highest placing in each event.

## August 26, 2020, Wednesday, 10:00 am

**Ranch Horse Cutting:** To be eligible, horse cannot have been professionally trained for or competed in any regular cutting contest. Limit 2 horses per rider, one go per horse, two corner riders and two turn back riders allowed. Two and a half minute time limit with a 30 second warning. Horses will be scored by a judge using the 60-80 system. No other rules apply. Entry fee \$20.

**Single Cow Fencework:** The horse and rider will perform "fencework" with a single cow. The horse will demonstrate ability to control the cow within a 2 1/2 minute time limit. Each contestant, upon receiving the cow, shall hold the cow at the end of the arena for sufficient time to demonstrate the horse's ability to hold the cow. The rider will then take the cow down the fence, making at least one turn each direction on the fence. The rider will then take the cow to the middle of the arena and circle it at least once in each direction. The performance will be scored on the 60-80 system. AQHA rules apply. Limit 2 horses per rider. Entry Fee \$20.

## August 26, 2020, Wednesday, 2:00 pm

**Ranch Sorting:** Teams will consist of three members. Each team will begin with a pen of 11 or 12 cattle, ten of which are numbered 0-9. The team will be given a number to start, at which time they have two minutes to sort the cattle across a marked line of the arena in order beginning with their number. The team will receive a "no-time" when the first animal across the line is out of order or when an animal that has already been sorted comes back across the line. The team with the most cattle over the line or the fastest time on all ten will win. Limit 3 entries per rider. Entry fee \$20 per man or \$60 per team.

**Novice Sorting:** Teams will consist of two members under 12 and one older member. No rancher roundup points in this event. Limit 3 entries per rider. Entry fee \$10 per man or \$30 per team.

**Junior Sorting:** Teams will consist of three members under the age of 18. No rancher roundup points in this event. Limit 3 entries per rider. Entry fee \$10 per man or \$30 per team.

## August 26, 2020, Wednesday, 5:00 pm

**SRRA Drainage Team Roping-** Points for Rancher Roundup will be taken from Open Drainage Roping. Points only awarded to residents or natives of the Salmon River Drainage.
