*Eastern Idaho State Fair (EISF) Qualifying Classes -if qualify , Must COMPLETE ENTRY FORM DAY OF SHOW!

A- This class is open to youth who just want to walk/trot Western. You cannot enter this class and regular bareback equitation or regular Western Equitation!
B- Youth showing in 1st year walk/trot equitation may only show in following classes: showmanship at

halter; walk/trot equitation; walk/trot trail. They will not be eligible to qualify for the Eastern Idaho State Fair in trail. Only first year 4-H members competing in this class will be eligible to attend EISF. (EISF rule)
E- Trail course will open from 10:30 to 2:00. No practicing course day of the show.

F- Each team sorting team will compete two times. You may only be on one “regular” team and one draw team. Teams qualifying for EISF must have qualified as a team. If one team member cannot attend, 1 alternate may be used.
G- Those entering ground roping may not enter dummy roping also.
