Submission Guidelines

- Only framed or gallery wrapped original work having a wire stretching fully from side-to-side for hanging will be accepted. Other hangers e.g. tape, string, yarn, sawtooth hangers, etc. will be disqualified.
- With the exception of gallery wrapped works on canvas, all pieces must be behind glass, acrylic or plexiglas.
- Each Exhibitor may enter multiple works in multiple Categories but is limited to only one entry per Class in a Category.
- Submissions may be pre-entered at the Purple Easel Gallery prior to August 20. (Please call 756-8839 to make arrangements) OR Monday, August 21 from 5:30 –7:30pm at the fairgrounds.
- Please have your Entry Form and Exhibit Tag completed prior to arriving at the Fair for submission.
- Submissions will be hung on a first come, first serve basis AS SPACE ALLOWS.
- Submissions must have been created within the past three years and not previously shown at this Fair.
- Submissions must be entirely the work of the Exhibitor, not copied from another artist's work including the recognized reproduction of another artist's visual image, painting or photograph.
- The Superintendent and Judge reserve the right to disqualify any submission based on the quality of mount, presentation and/or the recognized reproduction of another art work.
- The Superintendent and Judge reserve the right to change the Division, Category and/or Class of any entry.
- Care will be taken to promote the safety of your submission. However, the Fair Management, Superintendents and helpers are not responsible for damage to, or loss of, any submission.
- Entries will be available to pick-up Sunday, August 27 from 1:00pm—3:00pm. Entries not picked up will be made available at the Purple Easel Gallery after September 6. Entries not claimed by September 30th will be forfeited and become the property of the Art Department.
