Submission Guidelines

- 1. Entries are limited to Lemhi County grown products and must be grown by exhibitor.
- 2. *NOTE!* Limit of 30 entries per person (due to limited exhibit space).
- 3. **NOTE!** 1 entry per class or variety per person (except where noted).
- 4. All articles must be cleaned and prepared for exhibit prior to entry.
- 5. In general, only trim roots (clean), Trim stems to 1"-2".
- 6. Entries to be judged on lack of defects, and condition (i.e. smooth, unblemished surfaces, free from worm holes or disease). Entries also judged on form typical for variety (most acceptable commercial size and color). In general entries will be judged on the kind of vegetable or fruit a customer shopping for produce will prefer.
