## Class C-Quilted + Mid/Long Arm

### Machine Mounted on a Frame

1. Pieced
2. Appliqued
3. Mixed Technique
4. Hand Embroidered
5. Machine Embroidered

### Class D & Other Quilting

1. Tied
2. Crib sized baby quilts (*perimeter less than 160"*)
3. Miniature quilt (*perimeter under 56"*)
4. Crazy
5. Yo-Yo
6. Painted
7. Group project by 2 or more people

### Class E -Art Quilts

Must be 20" x 28" or smaller- Unframed, Original work  
NOT derived from purchased pattern.

### Class F Challenge-Whole Cloth Quilts

1. Hand Stitched
2. Machine Stitched
3. Professional

### Class G Machine Pieced

Machine Pieced-Machine Quilted (*Quilted by Self*)

*\*\*Quilted by self means entrant has not made money quilting\*\**

- ◆ All Blue Ribbon items are eligible for Grand and Reserve Grand Champions
- ◆ Not eligible if previously shown in this fair.
