

# General Rules and Regulations

1. Lemhi County Residents are eligible to enter in all departments.
2. Competition is defined as a contest of supremacy between two or more animals, products, or articles owned by separate exhibitors.
3. Awards will be made according to the merits of the exhibit.
4. Attendants at exhibits and concessions must be neatly attired and conduct themselves in a quiet and orderly manner.
5. No diseased or inferior stock or articles will be assigned space on the fairgrounds for exhibition purposes.
6. All dogs on the Lemhi County Fairgrounds must be leashed by a leash no more than six (6) feet in length at all times during any and all times authorized events are taking place on such grounds. Persons whose dogs are participating in authorized events are exempt from this section while their animals are actually participating in such events. Service dogs, such as seeing-eye dogs and police K-9's, are exempt from this section. **NO ANIMALS ALLOWED IN BARNS OR BUILDINGS EXCEPT DURING SANCTIONED EVENTS.**
7. Exhibitors must be the bonafide owners of the article or animal exhibited.
8. The Fair Board reserves the right to reject any exhibit offered.
9. The Fair Board will not pay a cash premium on any article not specifically mentioned in the premium list.
10. Exhibitors must use the space assigned to them. If commercial exhibits are not displayed by 10:00 am on Wednesday, the Fair Board will have the right to rent person's space to someone else and the fee paid will be forfeited.
11. No straw allowed. Shavings will be furnished for bedding.
12. Any person attempting to influence the judges in their decisions in any manner will forfeit all premiums awarded and will be excluded from all competition and exhibition.
13. The judges will be expected, if called upon, to give the positive reasons for their decisions.
14. The Superintendents are responsible to enter the exhibits in the class.
15. The Lemhi County Fair Board reserves the right to interpret all rules and regulations, and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions, and differences in regard thereto, and also reserves the right to amend and add to

- these rules.
16. All protests must be submitted in writing, setting forth grounds for the protest. Protests against the exhibition of any article or animal must be filed with the Secretary at least twenty-four hours before the awards are made. Protests against the awards must be filed with the Secretary no later than 4:00 pm of the day following upon which the awards were made. The party protesting must deposit \$20.00 which will be returned or forfeited depending upon the verdict.
  17. Articles winning prizes at previous Lemhi County Fairs are not eligible again. This does not include livestock. No animal will be permitted in the breeding class that is entered the market animal classes or sale.
  18. Sales of exhibits may be made for delivery at the close of the fair, but no exhibit may be removed until Sunday at 2:00 pm with the exception of livestock which may be released at 7:00 pm on Saturday.
  19. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal or article exhibited by, or him, and shall indemnify the Fair District against all legal proceedings in regards thereto.
  20. The fair board reserves the right to refuse admittance or remove from the grounds all unmanageable animals which endanger the public safety or damage property.
  21. Exhibitors of animals, machinery in motion, and other exhibits liable to occasional accidents, injury or damage to persons coming in contact with them shall guard their exhibits and protect the public from coming in contact therewith and every such exhibitor shall indemnify the Lemhi County Fair District from and against all claims, demands, costs, charges, and expenses which may occur by reason of any exhibit not properly guarded or the public not being properly guarded therefrom.
  22. No bikes or skateboards allowed in bldg.
- Rules of the Arena**
1. Exhibitors shall not attach evidence of previous awards to any animal or article prior to being judged at the fair.
  2. Exhibitors of livestock must learn the hour of judging and showing from the superintendents.
  3. Registration papers for purebred animals

must be made available to the livestock superintendents.

4. Disrespect shown to any award or to any judge by an exhibitor forfeits all the award made to him.
5. Every exhibitor of livestock is expected to keep his pens and stalls clean and sanitary and must regularly and properly feed and care for the same.

## Concessions

1. Raffles, lotteries, and games of chance will be classed as concessions and will be charged accordingly.
2. All persons making application for concessions will be required to sign a written contract and make a monetary payment with the Fair Board before being allowed to transact any business on the fairgrounds.
3. All concessionaires are required to comply with the State, County and City food and health laws.
4. Dining halls, lunch booths, refreshment stands and other privileges are required to be neat and clean and substantially built.
5. Charges for inside commercial booths are \$75 for an 8'x10' stall. Outdoor space will be \$55 per 30 sq ft. Pop and food stands will be \$150. Beer Booths will be \$350.

## **Lemhi County Camper Guidelines:**

*There are 15 camp spots available at the Lemhi County Fairgrounds. These are located by the small 4-H Arena. The Fair Board requests everyone consider the following guidelines.*

- \* Camper spots must be reserved at the Lemhi County Extension Office at 200 Fulton, Suite 202. Reservations will close on Wed. Aug. 14. Cost for each spot will be \$15. Fees must be paid at time of reservation.
- \* Priority will be given to those 4-H /FFA families, fair board members and superintendents who live 20 miles or more from the fairgrounds.
- \* Others may be put on a waiting list. They will be notified after Wed., Aug. 14 whether there is a spot available.
- \* Campers can start parking at the fairgrounds on Thur., Aug. 15. Please display the reservation form clearly in the front window or on the front of the camper.
- \* Please run the electrical cords directly from the outlets not from another camper.
- \* Park in designated area only.
